Dear Ambassador Raffaelli:

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4 of Article 4 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, I am instructed by my government to inform the Textiles Surveillance Body of the extension, with modifications, of the bilateral textile agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Bangladesh.

This extension was negotiated to deal with issues of market disruption or real risk thereof, while at the same time ensuring that its provisions would permit the expansion and orderly development of textiles and apparel trade from Bangladesh.

Copies of the notes effecting this extension are enclosed. Additional data to facilitate preparation of a fact sheet will be provided separately.

BEGIN TEXT

THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, GOVERNMENT OF THE PECFLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH, PRESENTS ITS COMPLIMENTS TO THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CHARA AND HAS THE HONOR TO INVITE KIND ATTENTION TO EMBASSY'S NOTE VERPALE NO. 28 DATED 29TH MARCH 1992 REGARDING THE BILATERAL TEXTILE AGREEMENT SIGNED ON 19 SEPTEMBER 1991 BETWEEN BANGLADESH AND USA AND ITS AMENIMENTS THEREOF.

THE MINISTRY HAS THE PRIVILEGE OF INFORMING THE EMPASSY THAT THE AMENDMENTS MENTIONED IN THE SAID NOTE VERPALE ARE ACCEPTABLE TO THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE.

THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, THEREFORE, REQUESTS THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN DHAKA FOR TAKING NECESSARY STEPS SO THAT THE AGREEMENT COULD BE RATIFIED BY THE CONCERNED AUTHORITIES IN THE USA.

THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AVAILS ITSELF OF THIS CPPCRTUNITY TO RENEW TO THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA THE ASSURANCES OF ITS HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.

THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA HAS THE HONOR TO REFER THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLACESH TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING OF 19 SEPTEMBER 1991 PETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATE OF AMERICA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLACESH CONCERNING TRADE IN CERTAIN APPAREL AND OTHER TEXTILE CATIGORIES (HEREINAFTER KNOWN AS THE AGREEMENT); TO THIS EMBASSI'S NOTE OF 20 JANUARY 1992 PROPOSING AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT; AND, TO THE NOTE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH OF 3

FEBRUARY 1992 CONCERNING ACCEPTANCE OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS AND FORMALIZATION OF THE AGREEMENT SUBJECT TO CERTAIN OBSERVATIONS.

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES HAS TAKEN THESE CBSERVATIONS UNDER ADVISEMENT AND CONCURS WITH THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT:

--- IN PARAGRAPH 4 OF THE AGREEMENT, THE PHRASE "10 PERCENT BETWEEN 335 AND 336," SHOULD READ "10 PERCENT BETWEEN 335 AND 635."

A NEW PARAGRAPH 5 SHOULD BE CREATED ANT THE PRESENT PARAGRAPH 5 SHOULD BECOME PARAGRAPH 6. THE NEW PARAGRAPH 5 SHOULD READ: "SPECIAL SHIFT OF 11.25 PERCENT SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR EITHER CATEGORY 338/319 OR 638/639, PROVIDED THAT AN EQUIVALENT AMOUNT IN SQUARE METERS IS DEDUCTED FROM THE OTHER CATEGORY IN THE SAME AGREEMENT YEAR. THE SQUARE METER EQUIVALENT CONVERSION FACTOR FOR 338/339 SHALL BE 6.0; THE SQUARE METER EQUIVALENT CONVERSION FACTOR FOR 638/639 SHALL BE 12.96."

HOWEVER, SINCE THE PROPOSED AGREEMENT IS AN ALL INCLUSIVE CONSOLIDATION OF THE PRESENT AGREEMENT AND ALL ITS EXISTING AMENDMENTS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES DOES NOT CONSIDER IT NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE TO AMEND THE PROPOSED AGREEMENT WITH THE FOLLOWING SENTENCE SUBMITTED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH: "PROVISIONS OF THE CURRENT AGREEMENT NOT AFFECTED BY THIS AMENDMENT WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT."

IF THE FOREGOING IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE GOVERNMENT OF BANGLADESH THEN THIS NOTE AND THE NOTE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH IN CONFIRMATION SHALL CONSTITUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS HAS THE PRIVILEGE OF INFORMING THE ESTEEMED EMBASSY THAT THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF USA THROUGH THEIR NOTE VERBALE NO. 206 ARE ACCEPTABLE TO THE CONCERNED AUTHORITIES C BANGLADESH SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING OBSTRYATIONS:

- I) THE AGREEMENT MAY CONTAIN THE SENTENCE "PROVISIONS OF THE CURRENT AGREEMENT NOT AFFECTED BY THIS AMENDMENT WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT."
- II) AT PARA 3 OF THE AGREEMENT SIGNED ON 19-9-1992 SPECIAL SHIFT, AMONG OTHERS, WAS GRANTED BETWEEN

CATEGORY 335 AND 635, WHILE AT SUB-PARA 4 OF PARA 2 OF NOTE NO. 006 SUCH SPECIAL SHIFT HAS BEEN SHOWN BETWEEN CATEGORY 335 AND 336. THIS MAY BE AMENDED AND SPECIAL SHIFT BETWEEN CATEGORY 335 AND 635 BE GRANTED.

III) THE AGRIEMENT MAY ALSO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING PROVISION OF SPECIAL SHIFT AS WAS STIPULATED IN PILATERAL AGRIEMENT SIGNED ON SEPTEMFER 17, 1987:

SPECIAL SHIFT OF 11.25 PERCENT SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR EITHER CATEGORY 338/339 OR 638/639 PROVIDED THAT AN EQUIVALENT QUANTITY IN SQUARE YARDS IS DEDUCTED FROM THE OTHER CATEGORY IN THE SAME AGREEMENT YEAR.

THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS HAS THE HONOR TO CONVEY THE ABOVE MENTIONED OBSERVATIONS FOR THE ESTEEMED EMBASSY'S KIND INFORMATION AND APPROPRIATE ACTION.

THE UPLIET IN 1992 FOR EACH OF THEST SPECIFIC LIMITS, EXCEPT CATEGORIES 237. 363 AND 634, SHALL PE TEN (10' PERCENT; FOR FVFPY YEAR THEREAFTER ALL SPECIFIC LIMITS SHALL HAVE GROWTE RATES OF SEVEN (7) PERCENT. THIS GROWTF RATE IS REFLECTED IN THE SPECIFIC LIMITS GIVEN IN THE NEW ANNEX A THE SUBLIMITS ON CATEGORIES 340-Y/640-Y, 341-Y AND 647-T/648-T SFALL BE ELIMINATED.
- SIVEN (7' PERCENT SWING SHALL PE AVAILABLE FOR ALL CATEGORIES. SIT (6) PERCENT CARFYFORWARD AND A MAXIMUM OF ELEVEN (11) PERCENT CARRYOVER ARE AVAILABLE IN ALL CATEGORIES; COMPINED CARRYFORWARD AND CARRYOVER SHALL NOT FICEET 11 PERCENT. CARRYFORWARD SHALL NOT FE AVAILABLE IN THE FINAL AGRIEMENT TEAF.
- IN ADDITION TO REGULAR FLEXIBILITY. SPECIAL SHIFT. WHICH SHALL FF CALCULATED ON THE PAST LEVEL OF THE RECEIVING CATFGORY, SHALL BE AVAILABLE AS FOLLOWS:
 - 10 PEPCENT PETWEEN 347/348 AND 647;
 - 10 PFRCFNT PFTWFEN 334 AND 335;

 - 10 PERCENT FFTWEEN 335 AND 335; 15 PERCENT INTO 641 AND 647/648 (IF DO?ENS) FROM ANY OTHER SPECIFIC LIMIT F7CEPT 331
- THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES FAS THE HONOR TO PROPOSE THE INCLUSION OF THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE IN THE WYTENDED AGREEMENT:
