Con relación a su nota de fecha 3 del corriente, llevo a su conocimiento que la República Argentina no aplica las restricciones a las importaciones de productos textiles previstas en el Acuerdo Multifibras.

La única restricción no arancelaria existente en la República Argentina respecto a importaciones textiles se refiere a la suspensión de importación de ropa usada, dispuesta por resoluciones de la Secretaría de Industria y Comercio Exterior números 1646/91 y 696/92.

Es de señalar asimismo que por haberse verificado importaciones en condiciones de dumping, recientemente se han impuesto medidas antidumping preventivas a telas para camisería, mezcla de algodón poliéster, originarias de la República Popular China.

Esa medida preventiva ha sido dispuesta por Resolución 193/92 de la Secretaría de Industria y Comercio Exterior.

Dear Mr. Raffaelli,

With reference to your note dated 3 August 1992, I wish to inform you that the Argentine Republic does not apply the restrictions on imports of textile products provided for by the Multifibre Arrangement.

The only non-tariff restriction that exists in the Argentine Republic in connection with textile imports concerns the suspension of imports of used clothing, pursuant to Ministry of Industry and Foreign Trade Resolutions Nos. 1646/91 and 696/92.

It should also be mentioned that, after dumping was found to exist, preventive anti-dumping measures were recently taken with respect to imports of polyester-cotton shirting originating in the People's Republic of China.

This preventive measure was provided for by the Ministry of Industry and Foreign Trade Resolution 193/92.
