Kindly refer to your letters No.TS/140-1.1 dated 14 January 1992 and 3 August 1992 requesting information under Article 11.11, 11.12, and 11.2 on the status of restrictions maintained by Pakistan on textile products covered by the Arrangement as extended by the 1986 Protocol regarding International Trade in Textiles.

- 2. In this connection I would like to inform you that Pakistan does not apply any restrictions under the MFA. The only restrictions in force are those notified to the Committee on Balance of Payments restrictions and contained in document No.BOP/310 dated 5 March 1992.
