Re: Fiji - Restrictions Maintained on MFA Products

We acknowledge receipt of your faxed letter dated 8 March 1993 re the request for additional information on other MFA products.

This is to confirm that all other MFA products (yarns/fabrics/made up garments) are not under any restraint or quantitative restrictions. The import duties on yarns and fabrics are 10% while duties on made-up products are 25%.

We sincerely hope that this information together with that contained in our earlier letter of 5 November 1992 will now enable TSB to determine whether Fiji has fulfilled its obligation under Article 2:1 of the arrangement.
