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

Dear Ambassador Raffaelli:

Further to my letter of 7 June 1993 concerning the extension and modification of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) covering exports of certain textile products from the People's Republic of Bangladesh for import into Canada, the purpose of this letter is to confirm that the Canadian authorities have initiated action to correct an error which had crept into "Annex I - 1993 Restraint Levels". The typographical error involved showed a growth rate of 4/4 percent for category 14.0, "babies garments". The correct entry should have been 7/7 percent. A diplomatic note proposing the necessary change was delivered to the High Commission of Bangladesh in Ottawa on 13 July 1993 and, as soon as a response has been received from the Bangladeshi authorities, a formal amendment to the MOU will have been effected.

I trust that this information will facilitate the review of Canada's notification of this extension and modification at next week's meeting of the Textiles Surveillance Body.
