Dear Ambassador Raffaelli:

Pursuant to Article 4 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles (MFA), done at Geneva, December 20, 1973, and to its 1986, 1991 and 1992 Protocols of Extension and Maintenance in Force, I have the honour to provide documentation relative to the extension and modification of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Governments of Canada and the Republic of the Philippines concerning the export of certain textile products from the Philippines to Canada. The relevant agreed record of discussions and an exchange of diplomatic notes is attached.

The term of validity of the MOU has, via this exchange, been extended through year-end 1994 and the restraint categories for the MOU have been modified to the new HS based categorization system which is now characteristic of all of Canada's bilateral textiles and clothing restraint agreements and about which the TSB had a discussion at a recent meeting.

#### Canada-Philippine Textile and Clothing Consultations

#### Agreed Record of Discussions

- Delegations representing the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of the Philippines met on September 23 and 24, 1992, in Ottawa, to discuss the extension of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of the Philippines relating to the export from the Philippines of certain textiles and textile products for import into Canada ("the MOU"), and its conversion to an arrangement based on the Harmonized System ("the HS").
- The two delegations had detailed discussions on the HS 2. structure and exchanged views on the matter of extending the MOU beyond December 31, 1992. They agreed to extend the expiry date of the MOU to 31 December, 1994. They agreed that Annexes I and II attached would replace Annexes I and II in the current MOU. The extension of the MOU applies to all terms and conditions in the MOU, including growth rates and flexibility provisions.
- The two delegations agreed that this extension would be without prejudice to any changes that may be negotiated in the Uruguay Round governing textile trade beyond 1992. They agreed to consult at each other's request on any matter arising from this Agreed Record especially on difficulties arising as a result of the implementation of the HS.
- This Agreed Record will become effective on January 1, 1993, subsequent to an exchange of letters between the two Governments confirming their acceptance of these arrangements.

#### ANNEX II- PREAMBLE

#### **PHILIPPINES**

- 1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
- 2. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
- 3. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments, are to be counted as of female gender.
- 4. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I are those which predominate by weight of wool, cotton, or man-made fibres.
- 5. Baby garments of Category 14 put up in sets for retail sale will be counted as a set. A set comprises two or three matched (ensemble) or coordinated pieces covering both the upper and lower parts of the body, packed and shipped and sold as a set.
