Pursuant to Article 4 of the Arrangement Regarding International trade in Textiles (MFA), I have the honour to inform you that the bilateral textile Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Canada and the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, which was to expire on December 31, 1992, was extended with modifications until December 31, 1994.

In this extension, the product coverage of the MOU was made subject to the Canada's new HS-based product categorisation system. The negotiated restraint levels were considerably increased for a number of products and growth, carry-over and/or carry-forward provisions were liberalized for virtually every product category.

Please find attached copy of the Agreed Record of Discussion extending this agreement.

# Canada-Sri Lanka Textile and Clothing Negotiations Agreed Record of Discussions

- Delegations representing the Government of Canada and the Government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka met on December 3-4, 1992, in Brussels to discuss the extension of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Canada and the Government of Sri Lanka relating to the export from Sri Lanka of certain textiles and textile products for the import into Canada ("the MOU"), and the conversion of the MOU to one based on the Harmonized System of Commodity Description and Coding System ("the HS").
- 2. The two delegations agreed that the MOU should be extended for a two year period, until 31 December 1994. They also agreed that, effective 1 January 1993, Annexes I and II attached shall replace Annexes I and II of the MOU. The delegations agreed that this extension would be without prejudice to and changes that may be negotiated in the Uruguay Round governing textile trade beyond 1992.

#### ANNEX II- PREAMBLE

#### SRI LANKA

- 1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
- 2. Unless otherwise indicated, swing is permitted from adult garments to children's and babies' garments at a 3 to 5 ratio.
- 3. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
- 4. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments, are to be counted as of female gender.
- 5. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I and in Group II are those which predominate by weight of wool, cotton, or manmade fibres.
