

TEXT OF CANADIAN NOTE OF MAY 1994

The Canadian authorities wish to refer to the Agreed Record of discussions of February 17-18, 1994 concerning the extension of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Government of the Republic of Bulgaria and the Government of Canada relating to the export from the Republic of Bulgaria of certain textile products for import into Canada until December 31, 1995 as well as the replacement of Annex I and Annex III of the MOU by the revised Annex I and revised Annex III.

The Canadian authorities propose that this Note together with the Republic of Bulgaria Diplomatic Note No. 4475 shall constitute acceptance of the extension of the MOU and the revised Annexes.



Delegations of the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade Canada and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Trade and Ministry of Industry of the Republic of Bulgaria met in Ottawa, February 17-18, 1994 to discuss the Memorandum of Understanding relating to the export of certain textile products from Bulgaria to Canada.

The two delegations agreed, ad referendum, that Annex I and III of this Agreed Record will replace Annex I and III of the MOU. The term of this agreement will be the period from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1995.

The delegations agreed that their respective authorities would communicate to each other their responses to the ad referendum agreement at the earliest opportunity.



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


