With reference to your letter number TS/140-1.1, dated 18 May 1994 referring to the TSB decision of 25-26 April 1994 and pursuant to Article 11, paragraphs 11, 12 and 2 of the Multi-fibre Arrangement, I have the pleasure to inform you that I have been instructed by my authorities to notify the Textiles Surveillance Body of the following:

1. That the Republic of Indonesia does not apply any restrictions on imports of textile products covered by the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, as extended by the 1986 Protocol.
2. Indonesia's exports of certain textile and textiles products to the US, the EEC, Canada and Norway are subject to quotas as set out in the respective textile arrangements concluded under Article 4 of the Arrangement.
