Pursuant to Articles 7 and 8 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles (MFA), done at Geneva on 20 December 1973, and to its 1986, 1991, 1992 and 1993 Protocols of Extension and Maintenance in Force, I have the honour to inform you of the unilateral restraints maintained by Canada on imports of certain textile products from a number of countries to Canada.

These restraints have been extended into 1994 at the levels indicated on the attached table. In the absence of agreement with the countries listed in the attachment, these restraints are administered by the Canadian authorities and quota shares are allocated to Canadian importers.
