Dear Mr. Raffaelli,

Referring to the request for information under Article 11 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles as extended by the 1986 Protocol, I have been instructed to inform you about the following.

As regards the possible application of bilateral quotas, there are no changes to be reported compared with previous notifications. That means that since 1985 Hungary has not been maintaining any such restrictions on imports of textiles and clothing.

On the other hand, Hungary had maintained a global quota on the imports of certain consumer goods, including textiles and clothing already prior to its accession to the General Agreement. The list of textiles and clothing products falling within the scope of this global quota is annexed.
