I attach hereto a notification from Sweden regarding a new Article 4 agreement¹ concluded between Sweden and Hong Kong covering certain textile products for the period 1 January 1978 to 31 March 1979.

Dear Mr Ambassador,

I am notifying to the Textiles Surveillance Body a new agreement concerning trade in textiles between Hong Kong and Sweden.

This agreement has been reached for the purpose of eliminating real risks of market disruption in Sweden, while ensuring an orderly development of textile exports from Hong Kong to Sweden and is being notified with reference to article 4 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, as well as the Protocol of Extension and the understandings set forth therein (L/4616), acceded to by Sweden through letter of 28 April 1978.

The new bilateral agreement represents a more comprehensive coverage than the previous one. This approach has been made necessary by the deteriorating situation in whole segments of the Swedish textile industry and by the real risks of market disruption which, according to past experience, an agreement covering only certain sensitive products would present to a country like Sweden.

The present system of comprehensive agreements, i a with Hong Kong, is based on a categorization into fourteen groups of the most sensitive textile products within CCC (BTN) chapters 60 - 62. These groups are:

I Stockings, under stockings, socks, ankle-socks, sockettes and the like, knitted or crocheted, other than ladies' stockings of continuous synthetic textile fibres

II Shirts

- III Nightwear
- IV Knitted underwear, other than shirts, nightwear and tights (including underwear T-shirts)
- V Knitted sweaters, pullovers, slipovers, jumpers and cardigans etc (including outerwear T-shirts)
- VI Overcoats and jackets
- VII Suits, lounge coats and blazers
- VIII Trousers, other than shorts
- IX Costumes, dresses and skirts
- X Blouses
- XI Clothing, other than listed above, covered by CCC headings 60.03 - 60.05 and 61.01 - 61.04 as well as Commodity List 18 in Sweden

(Note: Commodity List 18 refers to textile products under the import licence surveillance system in Sweden. It is annexed to this letter)

- XII Travelling rugs and blankets
- XIII Bed linen
- XIV Towels and similar articles

In this agreement with Hong Kong, separate levels have been established for groups I - VI, VIII - X, XIII and XIV as well as parts of groups VII and XI. The remaining products have been put under an EA-system, which comprises 14 items. No textiles under CCC chapters 50 - 59 are subject to restraint in the present agreement.

The difficult situation of the Swedish textile industry has become further aggravated during the last years. Imports of garments have increased substantially, while consumption has been stagnant. This has led to a further decrease of domestic production. As in previous years, a number of factories have had to close down in 1978. It should be recalled that Sweden is the country which has the highest import penetration in the world when it comes to textiles and the highest per capita import of clothing from developing countries.

For Sweden, which is a small market, with an exceptionally high level of imports and a low domestic production, the maintenance of a minimum viable production of textiles is of vital importance.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Introduction

This Memorandum of Understanding sets out the arrangements that have been made between the Government of Hong Kong and the Government of Sweden regarding the limits that the Government of Hong Kong shall apply to exports of certain textiles for importation into Sweden.

2. These arrangements have been made having regard to the renewed Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles bearing in mind particularly the provisions of Article 1 and Article 4 of the said Arrangement and the document known as COM.TEX/W/47.

Coverage

3. These arrangements apply to Hong Kong's export to Sweden of the textile products of cotton, wool or man-made fibres or blend thereof listed in the Annex to this Memorandum.

Restraint Period

4. From 1 January 1978 to 31 March 1979 the Government of Hong Kong shall limit exports to Sweden of the items listed in the Annex to the levels set out therein, save as provided for in paragraphs 5 and 6.

Swing

5. The agreed levels in column (e) of the Annex may be exceeded by no more than one per cent, provided that corresponding reductions are applied in other groups specified in the Annex. For the purpose of calculating

such corresponding reductions, the conversion factors in column (f) of the Annex shall apply.

Carryover and Carry Forward

6. If in the period 1 July 1976 to 31 December 1977 exports from Hong Kong to Sweden covered by the Memorandum of Understanding of 24 September 1976 as amended by the Memorandum of Understanding of 15 August 1977 are less than the levels specified in column (e) of the Annex thereto, the Hong Kong Government may, after consultation between the Government of Hong Kong and the Government of Sweden, approve the export of amounts equivalent to such short-falls during the period covered by this Memorandum or by ten per cent of such specified levels adjusted to annual levels, whichever is the less (carryover), provided that such exports are in the groups/sub-groups where the short-falls occurred. The Hong Kong Government may, after consultation between the Government of Hong Kong and the Government of Sweden, approve the export of amounts in excess of the agreed levels in column (e) of the Annex to this Memorandum up to five per cent (carry forward). The carryover and carry forward taken together shall not exceed ten per cent of the agreed levels in column (e) of the Annex to this Memorandum. Where the agreed levels are increased by carry forward, corresponding deductions shall be made from any levels which may be agreed in respect of the same groups/sub-groups in the immediately following restraint period.

Admission of Imports

7. The Government of Sweden shall not admit imports of the items of Hong Kong origin listed in the Annex unless such imports are covered by a Hong Kong export licence endorsed by the Trade Industry and Customs Department, Hong Kong, that the consignments concerned have been debited to the levels in column (e) of the Annex, as they may be increased by virtue of the provisions of

paragraphs 5 and 6 of this Memorandum.

Re-exports

8. The Government of Sweden will so far as possible inform the Government of Hong Kong when imports into Sweden of exports from Hong Kong that have been debited to the agreed levels are subsequently re-exported from Sweden. The Government of Hong Kong may then credit the quantities involved to the appropriate levels.

Exchange of Statistics

9. The Government of Hong Kong will provide the Government of Sweden with fortnightly statistics of exports of the groups listed in the Annex that have been licensed for export to Sweden and debited to the levels set out in the Annex..'

10. The Government of Sweden will provide the Government of Hong Kong with quarterly statistics of total imports and imports from other significant suppliers of the groups listed in the Annex.

Consultation

11. The Government of Hong Kong and the Government of Sweden agree to consult together, at the request of either party, on any matter arising from the implementation of these arrangements.

12. If the Government of Hong Kong considers that, as a result of the restraint imposed by these arrangements, Hong Kong is being placed in an inequitable position vis-a-vis any third country, the Government of Hong Kong may request the Government of Sweden to consult with a view to appropriate remedial action such as a reasonable modification of these arrangements.

13. If the Government of Sweden considers that as a result of the application of these arrangements there is undue concentration of exports or the possibility thereof in any particular product, the Government of Sweden may request the Government of Hong Kong to consult with a view to appropriate remedial action such as a reasonable modification of these arrangements.

General

14. The Annex to this Memorandum shall be considered as an integral part of it.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON A SYSTEM OF EXPORT AUTHORIZATION

Referring to the Memorandum of Understanding on a restraint arrangement regarding Hong Kong's exports of certain textiles to Sweden, signed earlier today, the following understanding as to a system of Export Authorizations is agreed for the textile products of cotton, wool or man-made fibres or blends thereof specified in the Annex to this Memorandum. The period covered by this system shall be the same as that agreed for the restraint arrangements.

2. Under the Export Authorization system no export licence for these products will be issued unless an Export Authorization has previously been obtained in respect of the consignment concerned. Export Authorizations are issued only on production of evidence of a firm contract for the supply of the goods in respect of which the applicant seeks such Authorization.

3. The Application for an Export Licence for the particular goods in respect of which an Export Authorization is issued must be made before the expiry of the Export Authorization. Export Authorizations will be valid for a period of three months. Export licences are valid for twenty eight days. The actual goods must therefore be exported within four months from the issue of the Export Authorization.

4. The Government of Hong Kong will forward via the Consul-General of Sweden fortnightly returns to the Government of Sweden showing the quantities in commercial units and, where the Government of Sweden so requests in actual kilogram weight, covered by Export Authorizations issued to Hong Kong exporters.

5. The Government of Hong Kong will, on request by the Government of Sweden at any time, discontinue the issue of Export Authorizations for any of the items concerned, provided such request is followed, within a reasonable amount of time, by a request for consultations in accordance with the provisions

of Article 3, unless otherwise agreed, of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles.

The Government of Hong Kong will, pending the holding of such consultations, issue Export Licences for the items concerned only in respect of those shipments covered by Export Authorizations already issued. Should such consultations result in the establishment of a restraint for the item in question, the relevant provisions of Annex B to the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles will be applicable.

6. The Government of Sweden undertakes not to invoke the provisions of paragraph 5 of this arrangement before the level of Export Authorizations for item (14) sails of man-made fibres, exceeds 56,25 metric tons.

7. In the event that the issue of Export Authorizations for any items is suspended, at the request of the Government of Sweden in accordance with the procedure set out in paragraph 5, the Government of Sweden would be prepared to consider giving its consent to the extension of validity of an existing Authorization by a period not exceeding 90 days, if it is satisfied that the failure to apply for an Export Licence within the period of validity of the Export Authorization has been caused by circumstances beyond the control of the person to whom Export Authorization was issued.

8. The Government of Sweden undertakes to admit imports of all goods covered by Export Authorizations issued before the time at which the Government of Sweden requested that such issue should be discontinued.
