Dear Mr. Chairman,

With reference to the discussion in the TSB on 16 March 1982, notably the recommendation to Finland to start the issuance of import licences to T-shirts from Pakistan as soon as possible, I have the honour to inform you that the Licensing Board of Finland made yesterday, 25 March 1982, a decision to grant licences to an amount of 190 000 pieces of Pakistan T-shirts. This figure exceeds the roll-back level (1 January to 31 December 1981) by 12 000 pieces, thus meeting the requirement of Article 3:6 regarding "level higher than that indicated in Annex B".

I have informed Mr. Bajwa of this decision and I am also sending a copy of this letter to him.

Please accept, Sir, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
