Dear Mr Ambassador,

In connection with the European Economic Community's Agreement on trade in textile products with Korea negotiated under Article 4 of the Arrangement and signed on 12 September 1979, I have to inform you of the following:

During the course of 1981 imports of briefs (Category 13) from Korea into the Community exceeded 2.408.000, being the level at which the Community can ask for consultations with a view to establishing a limit in respect of the Community under the provisions of Article 6 of the Agreement. The Community, having deemed that there was real risk of market disruption in this case, the two sides consulted on 27 May 1982 in pursuance of Article 13 of the Agreement. As a result of these consultations, and in conformity with the provisions of the Agreement, Korea agreed to limit exports to the EEC as follows:

In connection with the European Economic Community's Agreement on trade in textile products with Korea negotiated under Article 4 of the Arrangement and signed on 12 September 1979, I have to inform you of the following:
