Dear Mr. Chairman:

I am instructed by my government to inform the Textiles Surveillance Body of the establishment of specific limits for four additional categories under the bilateral textile agreement between the Government of the United States and the Government of Korea.

Annual limits were established for the 1982 agreement year only for eight categories pursuant to paragraph 6 (E) of the bilateral agreement (U.S. request) and four of these were converted to specific limits for the 1983 to 1986 agreement years pursuant to paragraph 6 (F) (U.S. request). The limits concerned are:
