Note by the Chairman

Attached is a notification received from the Commission of the European Communities relating to a modification of the bilateral agreement concluded under MFA II between the EEC and Korea.¹ This modification concerns the correct quota levels applied to categories 12, 14B, 17, 21, 70 and 79 during the 1981 and 1982 agreement years.

Dear Ambassador,

There is an apparent discrepancy between the restraint levels for certain textile categories concerning the years 1981, 1982, contained in the "Additional Protocol to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Korea on trade in textile products consequent on the accession of the Hellenic Republic to the European Communities" (circulated in COM.TEX.SB/653) and the restraint levels which concern the same categories and the same years published in the Community's Official Journal L 381 of 31 December 1980 (Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 3553/80) and in the Official Journal L 82 of 29 March 1982 (Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 661/82).

I would like to inform you that the figures in the above-mentioned Commission Regulations as published in the Community's Official Journals are the correct ones and had actually been applied by both parties in 1981, 1982. They should read :
