U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 352 FROM HAITI TOTALED 18,513 DOZEN DURING THE YEAR ENDING NOVEMTER 1983, UP 35.4 PERCENT FROM THE SAME PERIOD A YEAR EARLIER AND 75.7 PERCENT ABOVE THE 1981 IMPORTS. HAITI IS THE FIFTH LARGEST SUPPLIER OF CATEGORY 352. THE FOUR LARGER SUPPLIERS ARE SUBJECT TO SPECIFIC LIMITS. DESIGNATED CONSULTATION LEVELS. OR AGREED LIMITS ON CATEGORY 352.

DCMESTIC PRODUCTION OF CATEGORY 350 DECLINED FROM 616.323 DOZEN IN 1981 TO 518,300 IN 1982. IMPORTS INCREASED FROM 253,200 DOZEN IN 1981 TO 360,000 IN 1982 AND TO 415,323 TURING THE FIRST ELEVEN MONTHS OF 1983. THE 1981 PATIO OF IMPORTS TO PRODUCTION WAS 43.5 PERCENT, AND THE 1982 RATIO WAS 69.5. THE SHARP 1983 IMPORT INCREASE, 27 PERCENT. INDICATES A 1983 RATIO BETWEEN 85 AND 95 PERCENT.
