Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4 of Article 4 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, I am instructed by my government to inform the Textiles Surveillance Body of a modification of the cotton, wool and man-made fiber textile agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Hong Kong.

The United States on December 23, 1983 requested consultations with Hong Kong pursuant to paragraph 7(b) of the U.S. - Hong Kong bilateral agreement to seek a restraint on nine products (see attached list), from Hong Kong. Hong Kong, in accordance with paragraph 7(d), thereof, ceased the issuance of export authorizations through December 31, 1983. This action, in turn, modified the provisions of the bilateral agreement with respect to these nine categories for 1983.

The U.S. subsequently, as a result of further examination of market factors regarding categories 318 and 669, rescinded its request for consultations on these two categories. Consultations with respect to the establishment of restraint levels for the remaining categories were held in February but ended inconclusively.
