DRAFT AGENDA FOR THE FOURTH MEETING (1975)¹

OF THE TEXTILES SURVEILLANCE BODY

As agreed, there will be a meeting of the Textiles Surveillance Body in the Villa Le Bocage on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, 3, 4 and 5 March. The meeting will start at 10.0 a.m. on Monday.

The following are the main subjects for discussion:

1. Approval of the draft report on the second and third meetings held on 17-19 and 25 February.

2. Review of notifications:

A. Conclusion of notifications previously reviewed by the TSB

(a) Sweden/Hong Kong, Korea, Macao and India (TEX.SB/10 and Add.1 and 2);²

(b) Notification from Switzerland (TEX.SB/1 and Add.16).

B. Notifications under examination by the TSB

The following notifications have been reviewed by the TSB. In the course of its review specific requests for further material or clarification have been made. These are still awaited and will be circulated in the TEX.SB/- series upon receipt.

(a) Austria/Korea (TEX.SB/5/Add.1);

(b) Austria/Pakistan (TEX.SB/14);

(c) Canada/Poland;³

(d) Norway/Hong Kong.⁴

C. New notifications

(a) Notification received from the EEC on measures resulting from consultations held between the EEC and the Republic of Korea on the basis of Article 3.⁵

(b) Any new notifications that may be received before the meeting. These will be circulated in the TEX.SB/- series.
