## Textiles Surveillance Body

### DRAFT AGENDA FOR THE SIXTH MEETING (1975)<sup>1</sup> OF THE TEXTILES SURVEILLANCE BODY

As agreed there will be a meeting of the Textiles Surveillance Body in the Villa Le Bocage on Thursday and Friday, 17 and 18 April. The meeting will start at 3.0 p.m. on Thursday.

The following are the main subjects for discussion:

1. Approval of the draft report on the fifth meeting held on 25 and 26 March.
2. Review of notifications:
  - A. Notifications under examination by the TSB
    - (a) Clarification received from Egypt in connexion with its notification under Article 2, paragraph 1<sup>2</sup> (TEX.SB/1/Add.19).
    - (b) In the course of the review by the TSB of the notifications concerning Canada/Poland<sup>3</sup>, Sweden/Pakistan (TEX.SB/19), further information has been requested. This is still awaited, and will be circulated when received in the TEX.SB/- series of documents.

    - (c) Austria/Hong Kong - Article 3 (TEX.SB/27);
