PRELIMINARY DRAFT AGENDA FOR THE FOURTEENTH MEETING (1975)¹ OF THE TEXTILES SURVEILLANCE BODY

As agreed there will be a meeting of the Textiles Surveillance Body in the new ILO Building, Room VII R-2, on Monday and Tuesday, 10 and 11 November. The meeting will start at 10.0 a.m. on Monday.

The following are the main subjects for discussion:

1. Approval of the draft report of the thirteenth meeting (will be circulated as document TEX.SB/W/59).
2. Review of notifications

A. Notifications under examination by the TSB

- (a) Australia/Macao - Article 3 (TEX.SB/49);
- (b) Australia/Hong Kong - Article 3 (TEX.SB/62);
- (c) Australia/Korea - Article 3 (TEX.SB/66);

The replies received from Australia to questions posed by the TSB in connexion with its first review of the agreements mentioned under (c) and (d) above were circulated to members during the meeting held from 15 to 18 September.

- (d) Canada/Korea - Article 3 (TEX.SB/71).
The notification of the agreement reached between the two parties is expected.

B. New notifications

Any new notifications as may be received before the meeting will be circulated in the TEX.SB/- series of documents.

3. Continuation of the discussion of certain issues, e.g. Article 3(8) and Article 1(2).
4. Other business (including any information received on import surveillance systems).

Date of next meeting

The next meeting will be held on 19-21 November instead of 17-19 November. The meeting will begin at 3.0 p.m. on Wednesday, 19 November. This change is to avoid clashing with the meeting of the Group "Safeguards" which is scheduled to start on the 17th at 3.0 p.m. If the meeting of this Group is to continue the whole week it is hoped that arrangements could be made for such meetings to alternate during the period 19-21 November with those of the TSB.
