Description of content: This proposed rule would adopt a use of materials bulletin for plywood and wood-based structural-use panels (UM-40C) that references national voluntary consensus standards. This bulletin would also provide a labelling and a third party certification programme to assure that the building products used in Department programmes meet the appropriate voluntary consensus standard. The proposed rule would supplement the Department's Building Product and Certification Programme by requiring that certain additional information be included on the label, tag, or mark that each manufacturer would affix to a certified product. It would also specify the frequency with which products would be tested in order to be acceptable to the Department. |
