## NOTIFICATION

The following notification is being circulated in accordance with Article 10.4.

Protective chemicals

- 5. Title: Decision of the Ministry of the Environment on Advance Approval and Notifications of Protective Chemicals (available in Finnish, 3 pages + Annexes 7 pages)
- 6. Description of content: According to Chemicals Act (744/89) the manufacturer or importer shall obtain the approval of the National Board of Waters and the Environment for wood preserving chemical and slimicide (protective chemicals). A protective chemical shall not be manufactured, imported, delivered for sale or used without advance approval.

If a wood preserving chemical is intended for use as a paint, it may be manufactured and imported without advance approval. A protective chemical may be manufactured and delivered without advance approval if the chemical is intended only for export. Tests with a protective chemical may correspondingly be made without advance approval in order to determine its properties, effects and utility. In these three cases, however, the National Board of Waters and the Environment shall be notified.

The draft decision of the Ministry of the Environment contains the documentation requirements for the advance approval of protective chemicals. Administrative, chemical, physical, technical, toxicological and ecotoxicological information on the protective chemical is required for the assessing of the risk to human health and the environment. The approval is granted for a period of eight years at most.
