5. Title: Food Labelling; Reference Daily Intakes and Daily Reference Values (11 pages)

6. Description of content: The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is proposing to establish two sets of reference values - reference daily intakes (RDIs) and daily reference values (DRVs) - for use in declaring nutrient content in nutrition labelling. The agency is proposing: (1) to replace the current United States recommended daily allowances (U.S. RDAs) with the RDIs; (2) to establish RDIs for protein and for twenty-six vitamins and minerals; (3) to establish RDIs for five groups: adults and children 4 or more years of age, children less than 4 years of age, infants, pregnant women, and lactating women; and (4) to establish DRVs for adults and children 4 or more years of age for eight food components considered important to the maintenance of good health: fat, saturated fatty acids, unsaturated fatty acids, cholesterol, carbohydrate, fibre, sodium and potassium.

7. Objective and rationale: To assist consumers in interpreting information about the amount of a nutrient present in a food.
