NOTIFICATION

The following notification is being circulated in accordance with Article 10.4.

4. Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading): Cooked ham (HS 160241/2)
5. Title: Agricultural Produce (Quality Control) Regulation (1990) Concerning Cooked Ham
6. Description of content: The Regulation lays down additional quality requirements for cooked ham. The areas covered include labelling, composition, sensory aspects and inspection methods. These requirements apply only to ham producers who voluntarily join the Stichting Nederlandse Vleeswarenkontrolle (NVK) (Foundation for the Monitoring of Prepared Meat Products). This Foundation can issue quality marks to these voluntary members and is responsible for supervision of their use. Ham which is produced other than by those affiliated to this body or which is imported from other Member States is not required to comply with these requirements and can be sold without restriction.
7. Objective and rationale: The aim of these measures is to promote ham quality. The rationale of this voluntary agreement is to ensure fair trading practice and to inform and protect the consumer.
