Mountain-climbing ropes (HS: 5609)
5. Title: Amendment to Ministerial Ordinance Concerning Safety Standards of Specific Products under the Jurisdiction of the Ministry of International Trade and Industry (available in English, 3 pages)
6. Description of content: Mountain-climbing ropes are designated as "first-class specific consumer products" by the Cabinet Order (Enforcement Ordinance of the Consumer Product Safety Law), for which safety standards are established.

The points of the Amendment are as follows:
(4) (a) to delete the requirements of diameter of ropes;
(b) to delete the requirements for certain environmental condition tests;
(c) to add requirements for certain tests on ropes, taking into account their use as doubled ropes;
(d) to add requirements for labelling " $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ on ropes which are used as doubled ropes.
7. Objective and rationale: To relax safety standards in order to adjust to the change of qualities and actual usage of mountain-climbing ropes and related goods currently in the market, taking into account the need to harmonize with foreign standards such as UIAA.
8. Relevant documents: The Consumer Product Safety Law
