Description of content: The Commission is proposing to amend its rules to require that cordless telephones be equipped with security provisions to protect the public switched telephone network from unintentional line seizure and dialing, and to avoid unintentional ringing. This proposal would require manufacturers of cordless telephones to incorporate digital code word circuitry restricting access to the telephone network or ringing of the cordless telephone only to signals transmitted by associated base units and handsets.
7.	Objective and rationale: To reduce the amount of harm which is being caused by cordless telephones to the public switched telephone network and the "911" emergency services telephone system
