Description of content: This notice proposes a new safety standard requiring school buses to be equipped with a stop signal arm. The proposed standard would require that the stop signal arm be octagonal in shape, have a red background with a white border and the word "STOP" in white letters, and be on the left side of the bus. As for the circumstances under which the stop signal arm would be activated, the standard would require that it be automatically deployed whenever the red signal lamps required by Standard No. 108 are activated. In addition, the standard would allow manufacturers to provide a means by which the driver could manually override the automatic mechanism. 7. Objective and rationale: Safety 8.
