6. Description of content: These regulations will ensure that Canada complies with the Montreal protocol and meets its schedule. They prohibit the use of CPCs and halons for specific lesser-essential uses or where substitutes are available. Effective 1 January 1990 they prohibit the import, manufacture, offer for sale or sale of certain products made with or containing ozone-depleting substances, and amend the list of toxic substances in Schedule I to the Canadian Environmental Protection Act.
