5.	Title: Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards Air Brake Systems; Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment (7 pages)

Description of content: This notice proposes to amend Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 121, Air Brake Systems, to revise the requirements for the performance of trailer pneumatic brake systems in the event of pneumatic system failure. The proposal would require several safety features to reduce the consequences of pneumatic system failure, while deleting the requirement for a separate reservoir capable of releasing the parking brakes. Among other things, the agency is proposing to require a low-pressure warning system that would indicate whether the pressure in any of the trailer's service brake reservoirs is below 60 p.s.i. The system would include a lamp located on the trailer.
