- 5. Title: Federal Performance Standard for Diagnostic X-ray Systems and their Major Components
- 6. Description of content: The Administration is proposing technical amendments to the Federal performance standard for diagnostic X-ray systems and their major components (the performance standard). Amendments would cover applicability, definitions, certification of components, certification by assembler, identification of X-ray components, limits of responsibility, information to be provided to assemblers, beam quality, aluminum equivalent of material between patient and image receptor, assembly and reassembly of diagnostic X-ray system, linearity, field limitation and alignment for mobile and stationary general purpose X-ray systems, field limitation and alignment on stationary general purpose X-ray equipment, field limitation and alignment for spot-film devices, standby radiation from capacitor energy storage equipment, image intensified fluoroscopy (further limitation of the field), entrance exposure rate limits, and change in units throughout the standard.
