The provisions of the Decree deal with lifesaving equipment, i.e. lifeboats, rafts, rescueboats, immersionsuits, lifevests etc. The provisions regulate how much equipment a ship must carry. The provisions also regulate the capacity, function of lifesaving equipment.
