- 5. Title: Procedures for Implementation of The Fastener Quality Act (30 pages)
- 6. Description of content: The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) requests comments on proposed regulations to implement the Fastener Quality Act. The Act requires that certain fasteners which are sold in commerce conform to the specifications to which they are represented to be manufactured; provides for accreditation of laboratories engaged in fastener testing; and requires inspection, testing and certification, in accordance with standardized methods of fasteners covered by the Act. The Secretary of Commerce, acting through the Director of NIST proposes to implement the Act by establishing these procedures under which laboratories in compliance with the Act may be listed; laboratories may apply to NIST for accreditation; private laboratory accreditation entities (bodies) may apply to NIST for approval to accredit laboratories; and foreign laboratories accredited by their Governments or by organizations recognized by the NIST Director can be deemed to satisfy the laboratory accreditation requirements of the Act.
