Description of content: The draft contains requirements in conformity with SOLAS 74 (as amended), Marpol (as amended) and the International Convention on Load Lines (1966) concerning stability and freeboard of Swedish passenger ships and other Swedish ships with a gross tonnage of 20 or more. Special Swedish requirements mainly concerning one compartment passenger ships and Swedish fishing vessels are introduced. Certain requirements on foreign ships are included.
