- 5. Title: Amendment of the Regulation on Maximum Concentration of PCBs (Food and Drugs Law)
- 6. Description of content: Mackerel and clupeids, meat and eggs.

Following the maximum concentrations of PCBs which already apply for fish, milk and milk products, this amendment to the regulation on maximum concentrations of PCBs (Food and Drugs Law) adds maximum concentrations in meat and eggs.

This amendment also brings the concentration for mackerel and clupeids into line with those for other fish species.

- Objective and rationale: Human beings are primarily exposed to polychlorobiphenyls through the consumption of (fatty) animal products. Maximum concentrations have been laid down for meat and eggs as well in order to prevent an excessively high intake of PCBs.
