4. Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading): One hundred and ninety-seven items of electric appliances including electric air-conditioner
5. Title: Prohibition of Manufacture and Importation of the Electric Appliances of which the Voltage is 110 V/220 V Compatible
6. Description of content: As for the 197 electric appliances subject to type approval or report of import/manufacture according to the Electric Products Safety Control Law, the manufacture and importation of those products of which the voltage is 100 V/220 V compatible will be prohibited according to the schedule stipulated in the "Guidelines for Implementation of the Technical Criteria according to the Voltage Boost to 220 V".
7. Objective and rationale: In order to save energy and secure the supply of the electric appliances and materials suitable for the boosting of national distribution voltage to 220 V.
8. Relevant documents: Republic of Korea Official Gazette dated 2 September 1992, "Guidelines for Implementation of the Technical Criteria according to the Voltage Boost to 220 V" (text is available in Korean: 22 pages)
