5.	Title: Decision by the Council of State on Restrictions in the Use of Pentachlorophenol, Monomethyldichlorodiphenyl Methane, Monomethyldichlorodiphenyl Methane and Monomethyldibromodiphenyl Methane (available in Finnish, 2 pages)
6.	Description of content: The proposed decision contains the regulations included in EC Directives 91/173/EEC and 91/339/EEC.
	The placing on the market of pentachlorophenol (PCP) and its salts and esters as well as preparations containing more than 0.1 per cent of these substances is prohibited as of 1 January 1993. The restriction does not apply to substances and preparations intended for use in industrial installations for the treatment of wood and impregnation of textiles and as a synthesizing or processing agent. Use of treated wood is prohibited inside buildings and in the manufacture of containers for plant-growing purposes. PCP when used alone or in preparations may not contain more than 4 ppm. hexachlorodibentsoparadioxin. PCP and preparations containing PCP may be sold only for industrial and professional use.
	The use and placing on the market of monomethyltetrachlorodiphenyl methane as well as preparations and products containing the substance is prohibited as of 18 June 1992. The use and placing on the market of monomethyldichlorodiphenyl methane and monomethyldibromodiphenyl methane as well as preparations and products containing these substances is prohibited as of 1 January 1993.
