Description of content: The Food and Drug Administration is proposing to amend its standard of quality regulations for bottled water to establish a maximum level of 0.005 milligrams per litre (MG/L) as the quality standard for lead in bottled water. The Administration is also proposing to retain the existing quality standard for copper in bottled water that specifies a maximum level for this contaminant of 1.0 MG/L.
