- 5. Title and number of pages of the notified document: Federal Motor Vehicles Safety Standards; Child Restraint Systems (4 pages)
- 6. Description of content: This Notice proposes to amend Standard 213, child restraint systems, to revise the requirement in the standard that a rear-facing child restraint system must not change adjustment position during dynamic compliance testing. Change in adjustment positions would be permitted subject to certain conditions to ensure such movement would not injure the child.
- 7. Objective and rationale: To permit new designs in rear-facing restraint systems for infants suffering from apnea or other breathing problems.
