Description of content: The administration is amending the Federal Meat and Poultry Products Inspection Regulations to make safe handling instructions mandatory on all raw meat and poultry product labelling. The handling instructions include a rationale statement and address safe storage of raw product, prevention of cross-contamination, cooking of raw product, and handling of leftovers. The rule provides additional safeguards to protect consumers from exposure to possible bacterial contaminants found in raw meat and poultry products.
7.	Objective and rationale: Health; to reduce the risk of food-borne illness
