Description of content: The Order constitutes a set of specific provisions for rubber objects intended to come into contact with foodstuffs. The limits and restrictions concerning such materials have been drawn up in the light of public health considerations and take the form of compliance with a positive list of constituents and/or testing for total and specific migrations on the finished rubber object ready for use, as appropriate. The wide range of uses of rubber intended for contact with foodstuffs has also justified the establishment of categories of use, accompanied by specific inertia testing conditions in line with actual conditions of use. Finally, the text transcribes Commission Directive 93/11/EEC of 15 March 1993 concerning the release of the N-nitrosamines and N-nitrosatable substances from elastomer or rubber teats and soothers. 7.
