**NOTIFICATION**

The following notification is being circulated in accordance with Article 10.4.

5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Importation of Fruits and Vegetables (8 pages)
6.	Description of content: The Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service proposes to allow a number of previously prohibited fruits and vegetables to be imported into the United States from certain parts of the world. All of the fruits and vegetables, as a condition of entry, would be subject to inspection, disinfection, or both, at the port of first arrival as may be required by a United States Department of Agriculture inspector. In addition some of the fruits and vegetables would be required to undergo prescribed treatments for fruit flies or other injurious insects as a condition of entry, or to meet other special conditions.
7.	Objective and rationale: This proposed action would provide the United States with additional kinds and sources of fruits and vegetables while continuing to provide protection against the introduction and dissemination of injurious plant pests by imported fruits and vegetables.
