5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Pesticides; Proposed Rule Revoking Certain Food Additive Regulations (6 pages)

Description of content: The Agency is proposing to revoke certain food additive regulations for several pesticides which the Agency has determined "induce cancer" within the meaning of the Delaney Clause of Section 409 of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act. The food additive regulations being proposed for revocation include captain, ethylene oxide, mancozeb, oxyfluorfen, propargite, propylene oxide, and simazine.
7.	Objective and rationale: This proposal continues a series of actions revoking food additive regulations for additional pesticides found to "induce cancer" within the meaning of the Delaney Clause.
