6.	Description of content: The North American Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act, which gives effect to the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) between Canada, the United States and Mexico signed on 17 December 1992, contains revisions to the Customs Tariff.  These revisions require that the Marking of Imported Goods Regulations be revoked and replaced by those new regulations of the same name.
7.	Objective and rationale: To provide opportunities for predictable and transparent administration for the marking of goods from NAFTA and non-NAFTA countries.
