Description of content: The Administration is proposing to amend its regulations to establish reference daily intakes (RDIs) for vitamin K, selenium, chloride, manganese, fluoride, chromium, and molybdenum for use is declaring the nutrient content of a food on its label of labelling; change the units of measure for biotin, folate, calcium and phosphorus; and make consideration of selenium, molybdenum, fluoride and chromium optional when determining nutritional inferiority.
7.	Objective and rationale: To assist consumers in understanding the nutritional significance of the levels of these nutrients in the context of the total daily diet.
