6.	Description of content: The administration is proposing an amendment to the Federal Motor Vehicle Standard on lighting to allow the photometric conformance of centre highmounted stop lamps to be determined by a grouping of test points.
7.	Objective and rationale: Such an action would be consistent with the agency's requirements for other lamps and would lessen the testing burden for manufacturers.
8.	Relevant documents: 59 FR 60596, 25 November 1994; 49 CFR 571. Will appear in the Federal Register when adopted.
9.	Proposed date of adoption and entry into force: The amendments would be effective 30 days after publication of the final rule in the Federal Register.
