Description of content: The current proposal seeks to: (1) Eliminate toeholds that enable a child to climb out of a crib, falling to the floor with the risk of injury; enhance the requirements for rigid-sided portable cribs to make them similar to **(2)** those for standard cribs, including higher side heights; clarify the scope of the Regulations; and (3) set out the requirements for cradles in separate Regulations. (4) The high rate of falls associated with cribs underscores the need to eliminate toeholds that enable a child to climb out of the crib with risk of injury, especially to the In addition, the requirements concerning toeholds will harmonize Canadian requirements in this regard with the United States requirements made under the Consumer Product Safety Act. The proposed amendment will also harmonize the Canadian and American requirements for corner posts. 7.
