General Assembly (election of the Presidency [1 president, 3 deputies]) and Board of Directors (26 members)

Revenue of sales, contributions, certification taxes, government subsidies.
6. Activities:
 - (a) Standards-writing and certification
 - (b) Publication of own standards (Austrian standards for electrotechnics)
 - (c) The association has no public function (the legally binding character of the standards is given by the Federal Ministry of Construction and Technology. The observance of the standards is supervised by the regional governors)
 - (d) Member in IEC, CISPR, CEE, CENELEC
 - (e) No function in the sense of the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade
 - (f) Monthly bulletin "Elektrotechnik und Maschinenbau" ("Electrotechnics and Mechanical Engineering")
