This document on measures covered by the AG/DOC/3 series is being issued for the first time in the case of Pakistan. The information is based on material notified in the context of the revision of the agricultural products non-tariff measures - Inventory, supplemented by other relevant data published by the Pakistan Ministry of Commerce. Additional information relating to licensing was circulated to contracting parties in document L/5250 of 1 December 1981 in reply to the Questionnaire on Import Licensing Procedures.

For non-tariff measures (NTM) other than those covered by this document please refer to document AG/DOC/1, which provides an overview of the way in which NTM information is organized within the AG/DOC/ series.

I. Introductory note by the secretariat

- 1. Information on import regulations concerning agricultural products has been submitted by the Ministry of Commerce for the first time in response to GATT/AIR/1781. Additional information relating to import licensing procedures of Pakistan has already been made available to contracting parties in document L/5250 of 1 December 1981.
- 2. The Chief Controller of Imports and Exports (CCI & E) in the Ministry of Commerce is the principal licensing authority, who assesses the country's import requirements in relation to the foreign exchange resources available, allocating resources as appropriate to the public and private sectors. Thus, while, on the one hand, all exporters are required to surrender their entire foreign exchange earnings to the State Bank of Pakistan, the foreign exchange expenditure, on the other hand, is regulated by a high-level Foreign Exchange Committee, which is entrusted with preparing the annual Foreign Exchange Budget and monitoring closely the foreign exchange position of the country throughout the year. The Foreign Exchange Budget Expenditure is approved by the Cabinet, which also allocates the share of the public and private sectors according to the priorities agreed upon. The Import Policy Order for the year is then implemented in both the sectors by the CCI & E.
- 3. All imports permissible in the private sector are subject to prior licensing.
- 4. For the sake of administrative convenience, imports are broadly divided into two categories "free" list and "tied" list imports. There are also some items the imports of which are prohibited either for health and sanitary reasons or balance-of-payments reasons. Most items on the free list are importable without any quantitative ceilings; however, some items on this list are subject to specific ceilings in terms of value of licences issued in the previous year. Licences under tied list are issued under loan/credit/barter facilities, subject to the availability of funds. Details regarding the import treatment of individual items are given in the Government's Import Policy Order (1982). Pakistan invokes Article XVIII:12(b)(Balance of Payments Imports Restrictions). The most recent (simplified procedure) consultation in the Committee on Balance-of-Payments Restrictions took place on 23 June 1982 (BOP/224).
