GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

Note for the Executive Secretary

Paragraph 2 (a) of Article XXIX of the General Agreement provides that Article I and Part II of the Agreement are to be suspended and superseded by the corresponding provisions of the Havana Charter on the day on which the Charter enters into force. Contracting Parties, were, however, allowed sixty days from the close of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Employment to lodge objections to any provision of the Agreement being so suspended and superseded.

The sixty days referred to having expired and no objections having been lodged, members of the Interim Commission are hereby advised that on entry into force of the Havana Charter, Article I and Part II of the Agreement will be suspended and superseded by the corresponding provisions of the Charter.
